## Village of Milan

Effective January 1, 2012, Public Act 097-0609 became law which amends the Illinois Open Meetings Act and the Illinois Pension Code and establishes new requirements for Illinois public bodies. The law concerns participation in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF).

Among the law's requirements are the following:

- All IMRF employers must post, within 6 days of the approval of a budget, the total compensation package for each employee having a total compensation package that exceeds $\$ 75,000$ per year; and
- Any IMRF employer that approves an employee's total compensation package equal to or in excess of \$150,000 per year must post on its website, at least 6 days before approval, the total compensation package for that employee.

Total Compensation package for the purposes of the Act means "payment by the employer to the employee for salary, health insurance, a housing allowance, a vehicle allowance, a clothing allowance, bonuses, loans, vacation days granted, and sick days granted." This information is found on the second page.
Effective January 1, 2021, Public Act 101-0504 requires IMRF employers to include a link to the Employer Cost and Participation Information page posted on the IMRF website.
